




#### **TFL STARS GOLD AWARD**

As a school we have joined TfL STARS which is Transport for London TFL's accreditation scheme as a commitment to promoting active, safe and sustainable travel.

The school delivered 25 different travel activities, 15 supporting activities and 8 consultation activities, to secure the TfL STARS Gold Award covering many topics including road safety,

the environment, behaviour on trains and buses.
